Bingham Area Dental Center Welcomes Dentist Jerrold Cohen

BINGHAM - In June, Jerrold Cohen, DMD will be joining Bingham Area Dental Center for an interim period while recruitment for a permanent dentist continues. Dr. Cohen received a Doctor of Dental Medicine degree at the University of Pennsylvania in 1970. Previously, he completed a Bachelor of Science degree at Tufts University, MA. A Maine native, he graduated from Stephens High School in Rumford and currently serves on the faculty of the University of Maine in Bangor School of Dental Hygiene. Dr. Cohen brings extensive experience in providing oral health services to Maine people and teaching



dental students as well as serving on the Maine Dental Association Board and Maine State Board of Dental Examiners.

"I am looking forward to providing this interim care for the people of the area. My individual philosophy is to give the best possible dental care to all segments of the population," stated Dr. Cohen.

Dr. Cohen will be joining hygienists Marie Doucette and Jacquelyn Watson-Arsenault to provide oral healthcare to people of all ages. At the health center, Patricia Nurse, FNP and Carol Eckert offer medical care. The center serves over 2,500 people from Bingham, Caratunk, Embden, Moscow, Pleasant Ridge, Solon, and surrounding towns each year.
