Bethel Family Health Center now offers Dental Hygiene Services

BETHEL – Bethel Family Health Center is pleased to announce the start of a Dental Hygiene Services program for children age 20 or younger, beginning September 11.

Sharon Smith-Bouchard, Independent Practice Dental Hygienist, will provide dental hygiene services to patients 20 and younger, twice a month. Dental hygiene services include cleanings, sealants, preventive care, fluoride varnish treatments, temporary protective restoration, and referrals.

Although tooth decay is largely preventable, it remains the most common chronic disease of children aged 6 to 11 years and adolescents aged 12 to 19 years. Tooth decay is four times more common than asthma among adolescents aged 14 to 17 years.

Bethel Family Health Center is committed to holistically treating each patient. With that goal in mind, the Health Center has made marked commitments to the integration of behavioral/mental health services, assistance services and now, dental hygiene services.

“Everyone here at Bethel Family Health Center is excited about this new program,” said Dianna Milot, Practice Manager, “There is a real need for dental hygiene services in Maine, and our program is available to anyone age 20 and under in the greater community, including MaineCare recipients, and that is something we are very proud of.”

All insurances will be accepted, and financial assistance is available for people without health insurance. The program will not replace existing relationships that patients have with area dentists, rather, it will offer an option to those who find it hard to access dental care because of cost or distance.
