HealthReach awarded \$2,750 grant from Weyerhaeuser Giving Fund

WATERVILLE – HealthReach Community Health Centers is pleased to announce a grant award from the Weyerhaeuser Giving Fund in the amount of \$2,750.00. This grant award will enable the Bingham Emergency Food Bag Program to continue in 2019. HealthReach donated 100% of this funding to Good Shepherd Food Bank for the Bingham program. At Bingham Area Health Center patients are screened for food insecurity and offered emergency food bags when having trouble keeping healthy foods on their tables.

In her notification email, Anne Leyva, Manager of Weyerhaeuser Giving Fund, stated "We would also like to acknowledge the efforts of your local giving fund advisory committee, whose recommendation was instrumental in securing this grant."
