Madison Area Health Center Welcomes New Provider

MADISON – Madison Area Health Center will be welcoming Danna Lee, LCSW to the health center team this winter. Lee will be providing behavioral health services that focus on the total person and assist patients at difficult crossroads across the lifecycle. The Madison providers will recommend patients to Lee and she will meet with them right in the health center. She will work with patients on issues that influence their overall health such as coping with a new diagnosis, parenting skill development, or managing a chronic condition.



Lee received her master in social work degree from University of Maine at Orono in 2011. She brings experience working collaboratively with an interdisciplinary treatment team to reduce barriers to improved health outcomes for patients with end stage renal disease. Her areas of expertise include aging, quality of life issues, end of life issues, and impact of beliefs on behaviors. "This transition onto the healthcare team at Madison Area Health Center represents a culmination of life, education, and professional experience for me," shared Lee. "As a clinician I strive to understand each consumer as an individual and as a part of her or his particular social environment. I believe my international and intercultural experience has enhanced my ability to engage in clinical practice with an open mind and ability to hear each unique voice of the individuals our health center serves and I look forward to working collaboratively with other providers in this primary care setting to address the broad range of needs and concerns of our community members."

Lee will be joining physician Nancy Knapp and family nurse practitioner, JoHanna Davis. The health center provides a full range of primary care and preventive services to over 1,900 children, adolescents and adults from Madison and surrounding towns including Anson, Norridgewock, and Starks.
