Pre-registration for the 5K event is \$25, which includes an event tech t-shirt, or you can enter for \$15 and choose not to order a shirt. Day-of registration fee is \$30 or \$20 with no shirt. Pre-Registration for the 1-Mile Fun Run/Walk is \$20.00,

which includes an event tech t-shirt, or you can enter for \$10 with no tech t-shirt. Proceeds from the race will benefit the Richmond Area Health Center.

Prizes will be awarded for overall male and female winners, as well as top male and female finishers in 15 age divisions.
