purchased at Richmond Days waterfront events Friday night (July 22) and Saturday night (July 23). Tickets may also be purchased at Richmond Area Health Center.

The locally crafted canoe is a Wee Lassie model, which is 11.5 feet in length and weighs just 25 pounds. Suggested payload of 200 pounds. This canoe is valued at \$3,000!
