## Strong Area Health Center to offer Kids' Flu Clinic

Free flu vaccinations for kids age 4 to 18 while supplies last

STRONG –This November, Strong Area Health Center will hold a kids' flu clinic. Since the MSAD #58 school system will not provide vaccines this year, the health center decided to offer this important service for kids in the community.

On Tuesday, November 10, from 3:00 PM to 6:00 PM, Strong Area Health Center will provide flu shots for kids age four to 18. Vaccines are free, as long as a parent or guardian is present to sign a consent form. Insurance will not be billed. Shots will be given on a first come, first served basis, while supplies last.
